Improvements and New Features

Data Protection

- **Backup Conflict Logic Upgraded**

When incremental backups are running, scheduled full backups will not be skipped, but queued to run after the current job completes. This will ensure a complete backup cycle for all plans and allow users to more effectively prune thier data.

- **Data Size Enhancements**

The number of sites and subsites will be displayed when estimating the data size of a backup and restore job.

- **Job Detail Enhancements**

When users choose to download job details, they will now be able to see all sites, subsites, lists and libraries that were touched by the plan, a time stamp of the interaction, and the size of the location backed up.

- **Backup Data Management**

Users will be able to remove backup data only from the Job Monitor, leaving the records in tact. This will help with record tracking and for users who manually offload backup data to lower tiered storage. Users can also prune backup data from failed plans.

Administration

- **Active Directory Group Information for Admin Reports**

When using the "Generate Report" function from the SharePoint Administration module, users will be able to show information on which users are represented beneath each group

- **Replication Intervals**

In order to support more robust Replication plans, users can now schedule jobs to run ever 15, 30, or 45 minutes.

Migration

- **eRoom Support for Mail Pages**

The eRoom migrator will now restore pages as text files, with attachments being migrated as additional files.

General

- **Farm-Name Case Sensitivity**

If the SharePoint farm name is changed from upper to lower case, or vice versa, DocAve is still able to load the farm structure in tree-view.

Bug Fixes

Administration

- **Replicate from Staging Location**

Previously, "load from staging" only supported the overwrite operation in the destination. This issue has been resolved.

- **Keep ID Functionality in Content Manager**

Content Manager's Native Mode now allows users to "Keep ID" for their SharePoint ID for list, libraries, documents, items, etc.

Compliance

- **Pruning Policies for Network and Local Drives**

Pruning support for local and network drives has been added. Previously, only the media server data could be supported.

- **Archiver Browser**

Formerly, data could not be read from network drives in the browser.

Data Protection

- **Item-level Job Report (Detail Report) now available following completion of job**

When job is completed, users will no longer see "No data from report. Wait until job is finished." message.

- **Email notification during Item-Level Backups**

Email notification during item-level backups is functional.

- **Job Monitor**

Clicking on the Job Monitor no longer delivers an "Object Error" message.

- **Web Application with default zone URL different from IIS Setting**

Web Application restores during Platform restores will no longer fail when Web Application default zone URL differs from IIS settings.

General

- **Remove Backup Data in Job Monitor**

When removing logs, you could also choose to remove backup data along with each entry in the Job Monitor. This switch reset itself on GUI refresh.

- **DocAve login error message and GUI hang following 4.5.3.1000 upgrade**

The error message "JDBC exception on Hibernate data access; nested exception..." received during login following upgrade to 4.5.3.1000 no longer appears; Inability to login to DocAve via non-local server resolved.

- **DocAve Extension Archiver can now run on Win2003 x 64 systems**

Known Issues

Administration

- **Two-Way Replication with Sync Deletion on x64 Machines**

When running on a 64-bit machine, Replicator can only support the folder level on two-way sync deletion.
